Medicaid expansion is effectively building a better workforce while reducing the health care cost burden on our small businesses which drive Montana's economy forward. Since Medicaid expansion, Montana's nationwide health ranking has increased to #21, our highest ranking in more than a decade.

MONTANA JOBS

5,900 - 7,500 = # of jobs Medicaid expansion supports in Montana

BOLSTERING OUR ECONOMY

\$350 million = personal income linked to economic activity from Medicaid expansion by 2020

LOWER TAXES FOR MONTANA BUSINESSES

\$11.1 million - \$16.7 million = estimated tax savings for Montana employers thanks to Montana Medicaid

LOWER HEALTH CARE COSTS

\$353 million to \$941 million = estimated cost to employers if all workers enrolled in Montana Medicaid instead had private insurance.
